## **Im:Merse** **Jeremiah 1**

### **Think about...**

Jeremiah heard God speak to Him and he saw pictures that helped him see what God wanted to say. What other ways does God speak?

### **Im:ltate**

Jeremiah was just a boy when God called him. God had a big plan for his life, but it wasn't going to be easy. When things seem uncertain, it can feel difficult to plan. Yet we can know that what God has planned will always come to pass, no matter how long it takes.

When we feel afraid about the future, it's always great to hear a word from the Lord. Jeremiah was told by God not to be afraid, because God would always be with him - and that is the same for us!

Spend a few moments as a family listening to God, to see what He might say about one another. Remember: God speaks in a variety of ways: through pictures, feelings, other people, nature, art, and many more! Lean in and listen to His voice as you ask Him what He might want to tell those in your family.
