Think about...

Out of all the little babies that were born, Moses was protected until he was found by the king's daughter. God was watching over Moses. What kind of God do you think does this? Is He Good? Bad? Angry? Sad? Happy? Loving? Discuss this together.

When we talk about a person's character we are talking about the type of person they are. We can tell what God is like by looking at how He speaks and what He does in the Bible. He looked after Moses because He is a good God with good plans for us.

That means we don't need to be afraid, but we can trust God. We can know that He will protect us.

Give each member of the family a piece of paper and ask everyone to write their name and/or draw a picture of themselves on it. Take turns to pass the pieces of paper and to write or draw good things about each person in your family. They should be things that you are thankful for. Invite the younger members of your family to tell you what they are thankful for about each person.


Why not challenge yourselves this week to say good things to and about your family and encourage them when they feel scared.
